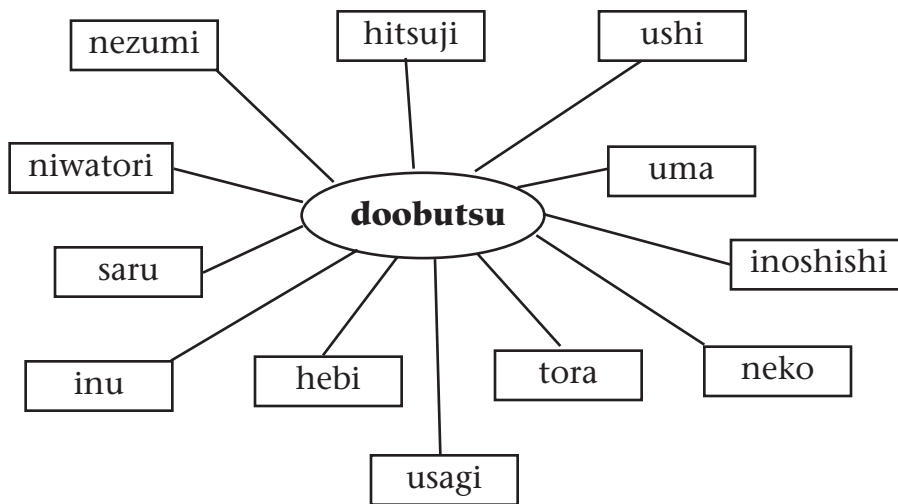
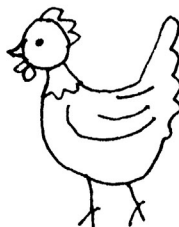

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## います — *expressing existence, possession, and availability*

You have learned that the verb *あります* (arimasu) is used to indicate the existence of an inanimate object. Another verb *います* (imasu) is used to indicate the existence of an animate being such as a person or a pet.

**Answer the following questions as shown in the example with accordance to the box below.**

**Example 1:** Q: *ねこはいますか。* A: *はい、います。*

(Q: *neko wa imasu ka.* A: *hai, imasu.* Q: *Is there a cat?* A: *Yes, there is.*)

**Example 2:** Q: *ゴリラはいますか。* A: *いいえ、いません。*

(Q: *gorira wa imasu ka.* A: *iee, imasen.* Q: *Is there a gorilla?* A: *No, there is not.*)

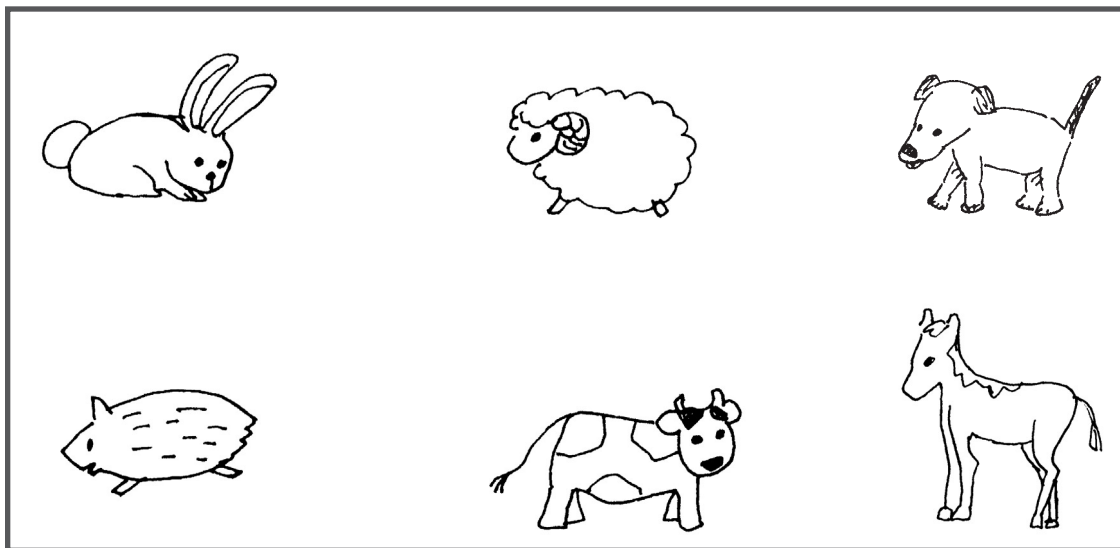

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## Long Vowels in Hiragana

Long vowels are written as follows:

かあ *kaa*      さあ *saa*      たあ *taa*      etc.

きい *kii*      しい *sii*      ちい *tii*      etc.


くう *kuu*      すう *suu*      つう *tuu*      etc.

けい *kee*      せい *see*      てい *tee*      etc.

(In a few words, long e is spelled with え : ねえ *nee*.)

こう *koo*      そう *soo*      とう *too*      etc.

(In a few words long o is spelled with お : とお *too*.)

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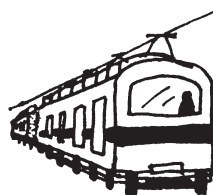

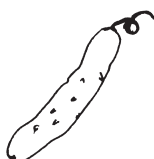

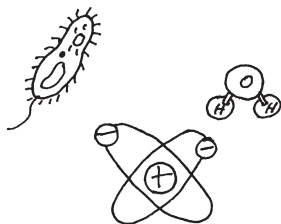
